Timothy Kahn is nationally recognized clinician and trainer in the field of sexual offender treatments. His recently revised book Pathways, is serving as a model for the treatment programs across the country. Mr. Kahn is the past coordinator of the sexual offender treatment program at Echo Glen Children's Center which developed one of the first residential institutional treatment program's for adolescent sexual offenders. He is a Clinical professor with the University of Washington School of Social Work, and served as the Chairman of the Washington State Sex Offender Treatment Provider Advisory Committee. The Advisory Committee has developed evaluation and treatment standards and licensing requirements for adolescents and adult sex offender counselors in Washington State. Mr. Kahn is a certified as a Master of Social Work, and Mental Health Counselor in Washington State and certified Sex Offender Treatment Provider. He currently maintains a private clinical and consultation practice in Bellevue, Washington where he evaluates and treats adolescent and adult sex offenders, as well as children with sexual behavior problems.
