For Foster Parents/ Relative Caregivers

This training is required for any foster parent caring for behavior management of sexual children or youth and/or behavior management of physical problems of children or youth prior to placement. While attending these classes, foster parents will complete a short self-study test at the end of the session. This will give foster parents and relative caregivers 8 hours of continuing training credit hours.

This 8-hour credit training will define “**sexually aggressive**” in both legal and behavioral terms, and help participants clarify the difference between “**red flag**”, “**yellow flag**” and “**green flag**” behaviors. The development of sexual aggression, from the causes to the thought processes, will be discussed. The training will include a dialogue about **appropriate community resources** and how foster parents can offer a safe and “**healing home**” to these children and youth.
